“As Jesus was approaching Jericho, a blind man was sitting by the road begging.”

Mark 5:24

“And He went off with him; and a large crowd was following Him and pressing in on Him.”

Matthew 13:2

“And large crowds gathered to Him, so He got into a boat and sat down, and the whole crowd was standing on the beach.”

Luke 6:17

“Jesus came down with them and stood on a level place; and there was a large crowd of His disciples, and a great throng of people from all Judea and Jerusalem and the coastal region of Tyre and Sidon.”

Mark 1:23-26

“Just then there was a man in their synagogue with an unclean spirit; and he cried out, saying, ‘What business do we have with each other, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who You are – the Holy One of God! And Jesus rebuked him, saying, ‘Be quiet, and come out of him!’ Throwing him into convulsions, the unclean spirit cried out with a *loud voice* and came out of him.”

“As soon as He was approaching, near the descent of the Mount of Olives, the whole crowd of the disciples began to praise God joyfully with a *loud voice* for all the miracles which they had seen.”

“Moved with compassion, Jesus touched their eyes.”

Matthew 9:36

“Seeing the people, He felt compassion for them, because they were distressed and dispirited like sheep without a shepherd.”

Mark 1:41

“Moved with compassion, Jesus stretched out His hand and touched him, and said to him, ‘I am willing; be cleansed.’”

Matthew 20:34

“Moved with compassion, Jesus touched their eyes; and immediately they regained their sight and followed Him.”

Luke 18:43

“Immediately he regained his sight and began following Him, glorifying God; and when all the people saw it, they gave praise to God.”

Luke 5:25

“Immediately he got up before them, and picked up what he had been lying on, and went home glorifying God.”

Mark 1:45

“But he went out and began to proclaim it freely and to spread the news around, to such an extent that Jesus could no longer publicly enter a city, but stayed out in unpopulated areas; and they were coming to Him from everywhere.”
